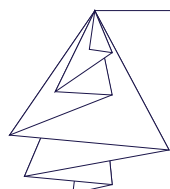
Intersect 1a with 3b.

Intersect 4b with 2a.

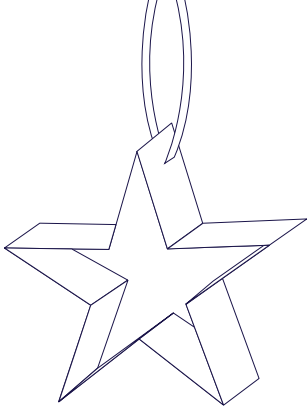


Finally intersect 5a with 2b,

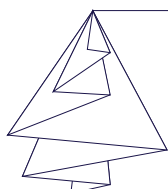
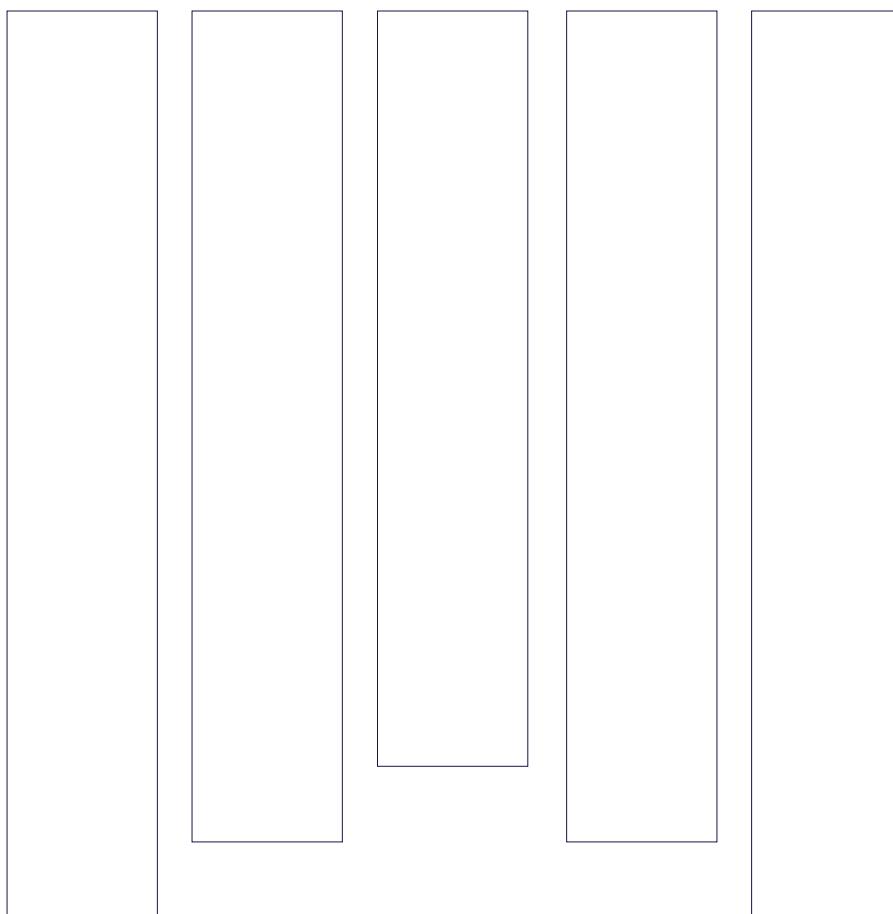
Add a touch of hand-crafted

Bring together all 5 strips, aligning  
at the top, with the shortest strip in  
the middle and the longest strips  
on the outside.



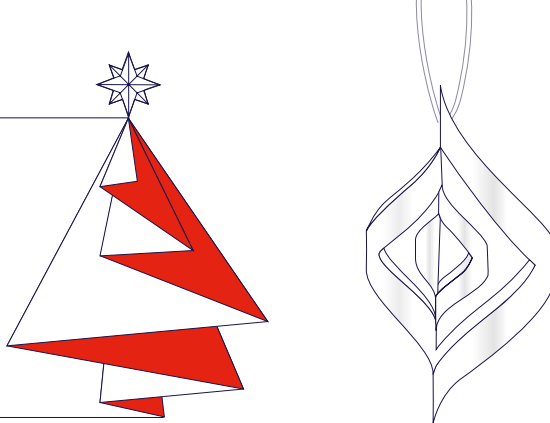
Use a paperclip to hold the strips in  
place at the top. Bring together the  
strips so they all align at the bottom  
and fix in place with a staple. The  
difference in length of the strips will  
naturally create a beautiful curved  
shape. Now you can fix together the  
top however you choose. You could  
use a hole punch to create a hole  
and tie together with ribbon.

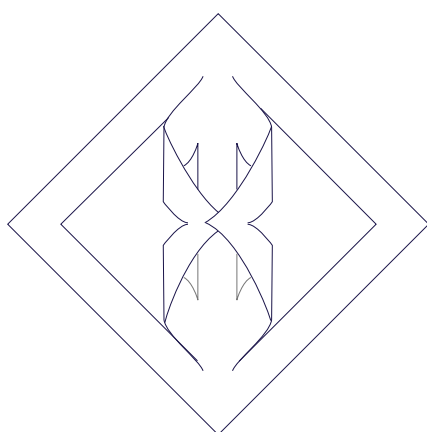
Print the template on page 2

different sizes you can choose from.



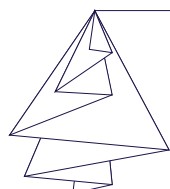
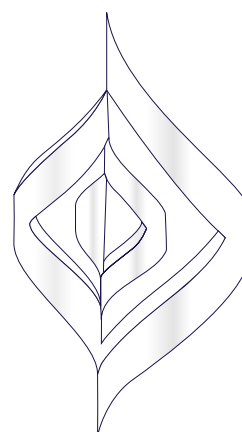
Fold the cuts of the smallest

the previous. Stick these together.

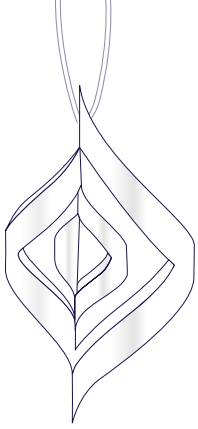


Repeat the steps turning the

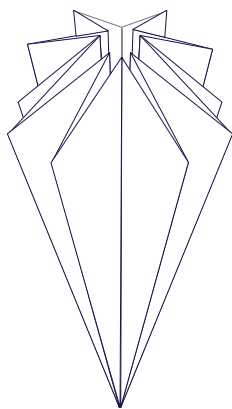


**Template:** Diamond  
**Level:** Medium

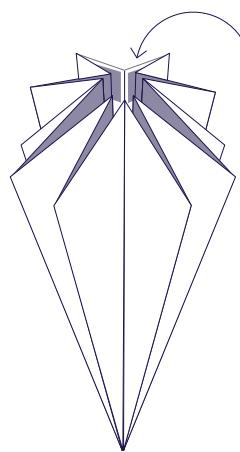

**Template:** 9 Pointed Star  
**Level:** Difficult

Worth the effort, this detailed star adds a wonderful hand-crafted feel to your Christmas tree.

To create the 9 points you will need x9 square pieces of paper. As this is an intricate design, for the first time you make this decoration we recommend you begin with squares no smaller than 200mm x 200mm.



#### TOP TIP

The stars look wonderful in a single colour, but why not try mixing a few colours, or print off several patterns to create a really interesting design.
